

SOLEDAD EXPRESS 3D/2N



Day 1

Pick up at Puerto Maldonado airport or hotel. We embark on the interoceanic highway for an hour to the town of Alegría where we continue on a gravel road that passes through a tall and beautiful tropical forest. Upon arrival arrive at the village of Lucerna on the banks of the Las Piedras river we continue by motorized canoe for two hours until reaching Lago Soledad. Box lunch en route. Free afternoon to explore the property and dinner at lodge.

Day 2

We wake up at 5.30 to the howling of the monkeys and take an early morning paddle on the lake with the catamaran over morning coffee. Fauna includes giant otters, maquisapa monkeys, herons, kingfishers, and caiman. At 8 am we have a full breakfast at the lodge. After breakfast we take a 4 km slow walk on one of our trails to see some of the rainforest giant Kapok and Ironwood trees and whatever wildlife will join us. We enjoy a regional Amazonian lunch and rest until we take a short walk to spend the afternoon at the canopy tower. We finish the day with a light dinner and go to bed early to be rested for the next day.

Day 3

We leave the lodge at 5:45 am and head to the macaw clay lick near Lucerna. In the clay lick we observe parrots and macaws in the treetops and in the clay lick until 10 am. While we wait we enjoy a breakfast. We begin our return to Puerto Maldonado to arrive at approximately 12 pm for lunch. After lunch we drop you off at the airport or at designated hotel.
